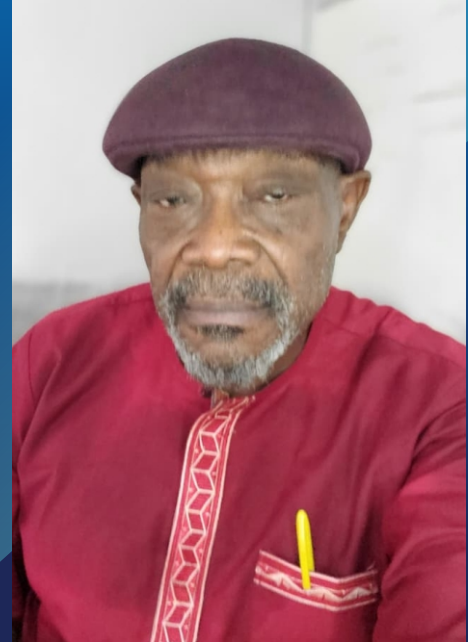

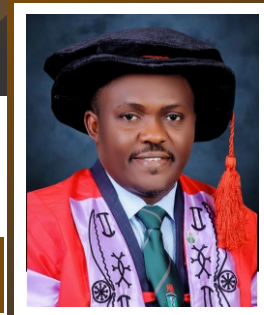

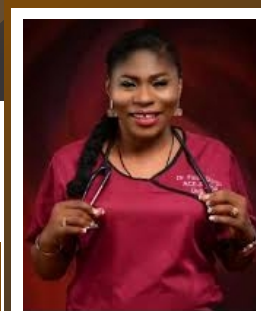
More than a clinician, she is a mentor, thought leader, and an unwavering champion for a future where ageing is not merely endured but celebrated with dignity and care.

Her advocacy for using gravity-assisted birth and other evidence-based techniques reflects a deep commitment to safer, more natural, and woman-centred childbirth.

Her influence extends into academic leadership, curriculum development for regional centres of excellence, and mentorship, shaping the next generation of midwives and health professionals who carry her passion for research, advocacy, and maternal autonomy into the wider health ecosystem.

His influence extends internationally, from traditional councils in Kogi State to engagements in London, demonstrating respected leadership, principled negotiation, and strategic institutional advancement. Today, as **Adjunct Director of the Institute of Natural Medicine, University of Abuja**, and **CEO of the African Alternative Medicines Hospital**, he champions research, integration, and professionalisation of evidence-based natural medicine in Nigeria's health ecosystem — blending innovation with cultural relevance to broaden health impact.

Dr. Uchechukwu Emmanuel Nwoku is a physician whose vision has strengthened Nigeria's national cancer response at every level — clinical, research, and policy. As a **Consultant Haemato-Oncologist**, he has delivered compassionate care while advancing systemic solutions that shape national strategy.

Dr. Nwoku's leadership is embedded in cornerstone policy documents such as the *National Cancer Control Plan*, *Palliative Care Policy*, and *Chemotherapy Safety Policy*, demonstrating his commitment to structured, safe, and dignity-centred care pathways for cancer patients nationwide. His scholarship, recognised by global institutions, fuels evidence-based programmes and data frameworks that guide clinical practice and policy implementation.

Currently serving as **Deputy Director and National Coordinator of the National Cancer Control Programme** at the Federal Ministry of Health, Dr. Nwoku ensures that Nigeria's fight against cancer is strategic, proactive, and anchored in science. His work has expanded national capacity to research, prevent, and treat cancer while advocating for systems that prioritise patients' dignity and wellbeing.

PROFESSOR MUHAMMAD ALI PATE, CON

Lifetime Achievement Award for Advancing Preventive Healthcare & HPV Vaccine Leadership



Professor Muhammad Ali Pate, CON, is one of Nigeria's most influential public health leaders and global health visionaries. Currently serving as the **Coordinating Minister of Health and Social Welfare**, his leadership anchors the Nigeria Health Sector Renewal Investment Initiative — an ambitious blueprint aimed at transforming healthcare delivery, improving access, and securing healthier futures for all Nigerians.

With a career that bridges national service, global health governance, and academic excellence, Prof. Pate's impact is both deep and far-reaching. He previously served as **Nigeria's Minister of State for Health**, where his strategic leadership catalysed the revival of routine immunisation and led presidential efforts to eliminate polio. His initiatives expanded vaccination coverage, enhanced primary healthcare, and introduced lifesaving vaccines, including the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine which has been administered to millions of adolescent girls, significantly advancing cancer prevention in Nigeria.

Internationally, he has held senior roles including **Global Director for Health, Nutrition and Population at the World Bank**, where he led the organisation's health response to the COVID-19 pandemic and shaped health financing strategies across low- and middle-income countries. His influence extends to academia as the **Julio Frenk Professor of Public Health Leadership** at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, and as a trusted voice on global health policy, system resilience, and equity.

In 2025, Prof. Pate was named to *TIME100 Health*, recognising him as one of the world's most influential health leaders — a testament to his commitment to preventive care, immunisation, health system reforms, and lifelong service to humanity.
